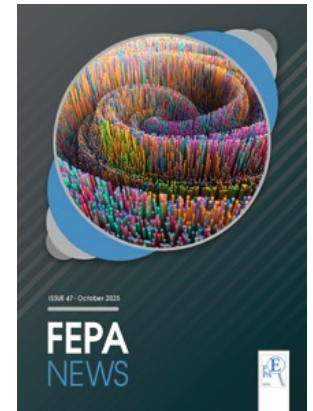


## About FEPA
